SUBJECT: Stadium Gate 20 and Gate 27

Gail,

We have apparently begun to use the passage way between Gates 20 and 27 as a place for dead storage or unused equipment. I assume you have made provisions for people to haul off the equipment. I notice that they still have not cleared, as I had requested weeks ago, the stair entering Gate 27 which is still a pile of dirt. It seems we need that doorway finished and we should get them on it.

I notice that Dr. Prineas has a notice published on the locker room in Stadium Gate 27. You should remark to him that it is not appropriate that he administratively oversees the building. That's your responsibility. You should put all notices up and give all plant instructions. Since he does supervise all studies there, he is becoming proprietary of the space and that must not be. Please get this point of view over to him, and to Phyllis as well, that administrative decisions which we make jointly in terms of buildings should be administered by you.

I also noticed that the hanging sign of the Laboratory in the ramp outside Gate 27 is gone. I don't know if you had taken that down since the outside sign has been prepared or if somebody took it. At any rate, you had better save the stand at least.
