Dear David.

I should be grateful to have confirmation or correction to the understanding of pulse rates indicated in the enclosed Memo to Menotti and Mariotti. Also, advice about the possibility of getting the entry resting pulse rates for Zrenjanin and Belgrade.

For unknown reasons the entry pulse rates for Crevalcore are not on the tape in Rome of Deck S. If those rates are not on the file in Deck S, col. 57-59, they must be in cols. 20-22, Deck 2, Round 1. On 4/14/76 I received a print-out of mean entry values for "Montegiorgio and Crevalcore, free of CVD and broncho-pulmonary disease," with N=1409. This must mean that Crevalcore resting pulse at entry is somewhere on the file. It would be appreciated if a printout of the pulse rates for Crevalcore could be sent at once to Dr. S. Mariotti, Laboratory of Physics, Istituto Superiore di Sanita, Rome, with copy to me. At Rome these data will be put on the file and used in computations in progress but delayed for lack of these data.

You may like to know that the ms. I showed you from the Rome group has been accepted "with pleasure" by J. Chronic Disease. The only suggested change was in the title. This now reads, "Identifying Subsets of Major Risk Factors in Multivariate Estimation of Coronary Risk," by Menotti, Capocaccia, Conti, et al.

I should be grateful to receive any output in response to my requests in my memos dated Nov. 25 and Dec. 12, Dec. 24.
