Sirs:

By March 20, 1972, I would be grateful for an estimate, not a quotation, for the following equipment, to be used in a planning meeting for upcoming national trials sponsored by the National Heart and Lung Institute:

- 1) 30 recording units for simultaneous 3 channel recordings of 12 conventional leads and XYZ, and all essential power and patient cables and electrodes.
- 2) Paper rolls for 24,000 ECGs with minimum 5 second lead strips and one 10 second rhythm strip.
- 3) Printed mounting envelopes or boards for 24,000 ECGs.
- 4) Similar specs plus magnetic tape recording for off-line analysis of ECG.
- 5) Similar specs plus simultaneous 3 channel recordings of ECG, carotid pulse, and phono or chest displacement.
