## Dear Alessandro:

I am preparing applications to U.S.P.H.S. for the period I December 1957 - 30 November 1973 and to the American Heart Association for the period I July 1967 - 30 June 1970. These are for support of the international epidemiology work not including the Rome Railroad men. I have no guarantee that these will be approved but I believe the prospects are good that at least most of the requests will be granted. And I have made provision for your participation which, I trust, will be satisfactory to you and Dr. Puddu.

Enclosed is a summary of the schedule for field operations. It is proposed that you would take part in all of these except Tanushimaru (1968), Belgrade Faculty (1968 and 1973), and East Finland (1969), and Zutphen (1970), in each case instructing the technicians and advising the professional staff for a day or two before the start of examinations and then staying on to participate in the work of the examinations which will average about 3 weeks for each sample. In addition, it is proposed that you spend 10 days in the spring of 1968 and 1969 checking interim deaths at Crevalcore and Montegiorgio, presumably in cooperation with Bruno Imbimbo.

The examinations will be essentially as at Crete last year except that we propose to make magnetic tape recordings of E.C.G. and perhaps pulse waves on all subjects and will provide special equipment and an experienced electronics engineer (from Dr. Rautaharju) for this purpose. Henry Blackburn will be present for at least part of the time in each examination period except for West Finland in 1969 and Crevalcore in 1970 and will stay throughout for the work in Tanushimaru and in East Finland. I shall be on hand for at least some days in all of the areas.

You will see, then, that your part in the total field work can be summarized in the enclosed tabulation. For your financial compensation I propose that payments be made by direct appointment by the University of Minnesota as Research Associate, the rate being fixed so as to cover: 1) Transportation costs, 2) per diem calculated so that you should receive a little more than what is comfortable to cover hotel room, all meals, services, laundry etc. 3) a stipend adjusted for the days away from Rome and providing for some increase in the rate as the years pass. The stipend provisions are given in the enclosed confidential tabulation.

Dr. Taylor will make separate arrangements for whatever is to be done with the Rome railroad men in the period April-June, 1967.

I trust all this is satisfactory to you. I am sending a copy of this letter to Dr. Puddu and providing copies also to Drs. Taylor and Blackburn.

Dr. Aravanis writes that he will need to borrow a skinfold caliper from Dr. Fidanza. Can you get this and take it to Corfu?
