Dear Henry,


I have had a letter from Zbynek Pisa asking us what we think about the possibility of a second edition of "Cardiovascular Survey Methods" - not altogether a surprise, though personally I had been hoping that if I looked the other way it might never happen.

I shall look to you for the main responsibility of deciding our response. It was you who did the lion's share of the work last time, and in addition it is in regard to your sections rather than mine that there have been developments since 1966. It would be no great task for me to polish and up-date my sections, but I am not competent to say anything about the more recently developed non-invasive techniques of cardiovascular investigation (although my impression is that, exciting though they are, they are not yet ready for epidemiological use).

My impression is that the book is still widely consulted, and I must regretfully concede that a second edition might be useful. I shall await your response with much interest.
