These will involve screening many. thousands of Twin City residents for high risk of heart attack. These high risk citizens will come to our Lab facility in the Stadium for regular visits, observations and treatment over the next 6 year period at a rate of 10 to 20 persons daily. From the standpoint of meeting our contractual obligations and the successful exercise of these first community-scale preventive programs on heart attacks, it is hoped that the Stadium renovation plans can be carefully projected to avoid their interruption.
