Thank you for your visit and for letting us know of your interesting plans for the Stadium. We wish them well.

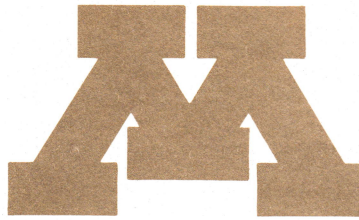
As you know we have a new program in the Lab of Physiological Hygiene, involving some \$700,000 in federal grants and contracts next year for a series of clinical programs on the prevention of heart attacks. These will involve screening many thousands of Twin City residents for high risk of heart attack. These high risk citizens will come to our Lab facility in the Stadium for regular visits, observations and treatment over the next 6 year period at a rate of 10 to 20 persons daily.

From the standpoint of meeting our contractual obligations and the successful exercise of these first community-scale preventive programs on heart attacks, it is hoped that the Stadium renovation plans can be carefully projected to avoid their interruption.
