Summary of September 22nd meeting with Len Schuman and Henry Blackburn

Acceptance of Alternate Students

Dr. Schuman agreed that any of the students now considered approved for admission for the program and on the alternate list could be accepted if advisors were found. I indicated to him that we would look over the folders again and would probably agree to advise Pat Elmer and perhaps one other. Pat Elmer is now in discussion with potential advisors including myself in the Laboratory.

Formal Teaching in 1983-84 Year

Dr. Schuman has agreed to direct the Epi I or Epi II course in rotation and season agreeable between him and Dr. Mandel next year and for that we are pleased. As the training committee meets in the interim, specific areas in other courses may be requested of him for the contribution of lectures, for him to consider.

There was no further discussion of researches since the joint proposal with Environmental Health for the Iron Range Project has not moved further.
