Reference is also made to the recent letter from Dr. Seaberg, Manager of the VA Hospital concerning my status. It must indeed be less than clear, this whole Fellowship situation. However, the only difference in our group is that we are carried on VA payroll by agreement with the University, since we devote at least half of our rotation to caring for Veterans as patients. It is hoped these letters will sufficiently clarify my situation. It is my understanding that virtually all Fellows assigned last year to the VA Hospital and on VA payroll have received their refund already.
