You are authorized to proceed with detailed arrangements for the Fargo/Moorhead Community Meeting. Please copy me on communications and send me lists of institutions and individuals to be invited. I would be happy to see this week a draft of the letter to go to the sponsoring and other institutions, and to individuals, containing the following thoughts:

This important research effort in heart disease prevention will involve intimate collaboration of Fargo/Moorhead and the University of Minnesota, as well as providing extensive services to the community. Organizations will develop which we hope will outlast the research.

We are asking you to select the key individuals in your institution who would be interested to hear about this program for the June 29 breakfast.

The meeting will be brief, with a very short presentation by Dr. Henry Blackburn, from the School of Public Health, University of Minnesota, and collaborators from the School of Public Health, School of Communications, and School of Social Work.

Dr. Blackburn will outline briefly the background of the NIH-funded project scheduled to last through 1989 and funded through 1985. He will indicate the proposed staging of involvement of community institutions and leaders and will seek advice and make contact with you for the purpose of continued advice and collaboration of the community.

I note your undated memo and proposal for that meeting suggesting four presentations by Blackburn, Luepker, Kline and Mittelmark. I think it would be preferable to give one brief presentation and then have those present respond appropriately. Dr. Luepker will not be in the country.
