It was found that the rate of oxygen consumption per unit of mass decreases as we pass from smaller to larger fishes of this species, the decrease tending to be least when the largest fishes are considered.

Experiments in which the oxygen consumption was measured both in fresh and in sea water showed that fresh water temporarily depresses the oxygen uptake and as acclimation takes place the rate of the uptake appears to return to normal. Evidence is given which seems to show that fishes may acquire an oxygen debt which is persistent for several hours.

It is suggested that the ability of the longer-headed fishes to withstand the two adverse environments to which they were subjected may be due to a relatively greater area of gill surface.
