

MEMORANDUM

RE: National Commission on Egg Nutrition "Infornam Deposition" with
Henry Blackburn

On 24 March 1975, when I indicated to Mr. James Fox of the NCEN that if he wished to bring an associate and stenographer to our scheduled meeting or otherwise document our conversation, that I felt FTC lawyers should be present, Mr. Fox summarily requested the enclosed subpoena issued on me and my records going back 10 years.

I trust that your interview with him has gone better. I and the FTC lawyers consider my request normal and reasonable and the enclosed subpoena as harrassment and intimidation of an expert witness who is not a litigant in this matter.

In fact, we see no reason why there should be any obligation beyond the expert testimony at the hearing.
