Dear President Ford:

If Internal Revenue Service Commissioner Donald Alexander was correctly quoted by the Los Angeles Times, I am seriously concerned for the viability and appropriateness of his administration. Any public official, regardless of attacks against him who used the kind of language he employed, calling congressmen a "goon squad" and "creeps", their inquiry a batch of dung, and their allegations stinking, is, in my view, a dangerous person to have in such a powerful position, with all its influence over the lives of American citizens. I request you not forward my comment to him as he appears to be an unstable and potentially vindictive person.
