Definitions

As Used Herein:

"Document or Documents"

Means any written, printed or recorded or graphic or sound reproduction, however produced, reproduced or prepared, any time since January 1, 1965, in your possession, custody or control.

Documents to be Produced

1. All non-published documents prepared, sent or received by you with respect to the relationship between dietary and/or serum cholesterol and heart disease and/or any attendant conditions, including but not limited to all documents stating your evaluation of research on that subject.
