This is to encourage you and your Senate Committee on Intelligence to achieve more effective controls on U.S. intelligence agencies. One small example of their pervasive influence is that photocopies of travel applications to my university Business Office were for years provided to the Central Intelligence Agency. Thus they were able to know the destinations and nature of my academic travels. This led that agency for many years to contact me after travels behind the Iron Curtain for intelligence information. It has been several years since I've cooperated with their information-gathering efforts which appeared to me to be highly inefficient and clearly invaded my personal privacy.
