Dear Ancel:

Ina and I have thought over your kind invitation to come to Minnelea and Corfu. We'd of course take care of our transportation, but we would rather like to come to Minnelea for two or three days before Corfu instead of after, if that is not making things too difficult for you, flying to Rome perhaps on Tuesday the 14th, to arrive at Minnelea on the evening of the 15th, which would give us two or three days with you before Corfu, where we would stay two or three days before returning.
