Dear Paul:

Herewith is a copy of a letter to Dr. G. Lamm which will, I trust, ensure that an application is made promptly by Dr. Gyárfás for a small grant to enable him to take part in the work in Crete.

I believe a grant of about \$750 to Dr. Gyárfás would be adequate to cover all expenses and leave him with something like \$200 as compensation for about 5 weeks' absence from his base in Budapest.
