Dear Paul:

I call your attention to the last three paragraphs of the enclosed. I think it would be desirable to provide some training for another and younger man in Hungary. But my personal resources will be so strained that I am concerned about costs. Very roughly I think the cost should be of the order of \$350 to \$600, depending upon the duration of the young doctor's stay in Greece.

This is not a second-hand application; you may hear from Dr. Lamm further on this. Incidentally, Lamm is awfully keen about getting away from Hungary. Any ideas? He is really one of the best men I've had to do with in a long time.
