I have examined the authority of the Postmaster General to use the special postage cancellation of which you complain, and I find that under the law, he has that authority. I agree with you that the phrase "work for peace" would be an improvement.

As soon as the 90th Congress convenes on January 10, 1967, I will consult with my colleagues on the Post Office and Civil Service Committee with respect to possible changes in applicable laws.
