Dear Dr. Lamm

You may know that I am responsible for coordinatin a series of research programs on the epidemiology of heart disease in Finland, Yugoslavia, the Netherlands, Italy, Greec Belgium and Japan as well as in the United States.

In the period Aug. 30 through October, 1964, the program in Finland will involve a field study on men in rura Finland in which an international team of experts will assis the Finnish team under the direction of Dr. Martti Karvonen of Helsinki. Dr. Karvonen is the President of the Finnish Medica Association and Head of the Division of Physiology of the Institute of Occupational Health, Haartmaninkatu 1, Helsinki.

Immediately preceding this field work, technical experts on heart disease and physical activity will meet in Helsinki on August 27,28 and 29 under the auspices of the Research Committee of the International Society of Cardiolog Representatives from Italy, the Netherlands, Greece, Yugoslavia, Belgium, England, the U.S.S.R., the U.S.A., and all of the Scandinavian countries will participate in this meeting.

I am pleased to invite you to attend the meeting i Helsinki Aug. 27-29 and to observe the field work centered at Ilomantsi (Finnish Karelia) from Aug. 30 to about Sept. 7. Dr. Karvonen, with whom I have discussed this question a few day ago, agrees and wishes to assure you of a hartly welcome.

At present I have no funds at my disposal to help with the expenses you would incurr in participating in this program in Finland but it may be that Dr.Paul Dudley White can advise. The stay in Helsinki may cost about \$ 10 U.S.per day and the per diem cost for meals and housing in Ilomauts: would be less. No fees would be charges for the meeting or for observer status in the field work.

I hope you can join these activities. Copies of this letter are going to Drs. Karvonen, White and H.L. Taylor (of the University of Minnesota).
