As far as the public is concerned, I think it much more important for you to get good reviews in the J.A.M.A. and in the specialty journals. It would also be quite a stroke if a sophisticated lay journal such as <u>Harper's</u> or <u>The New Yorker</u> would review it. I don't know how to arrange any of these reviews but will be very glad to write one of them from the point of view of the cardiologist. George Burch occasionally sends me books for review in the <u>American Heart Journal</u> and I may be able to get him to let me do yours. In any case, I doubt that the meat folk will be able to do you much harm.
