Dear Mother:

My requests have us gotten a complete accounting of your finances from Wesley and I can assure that they are being done in an extremely orderly fashion. The basic investments that you and Dad made continue to draw a respectable interest and they are stable and low-risk investments. Your basic bank account is in good shape, with over \$6,000 in checking. The reason you felt that this had gone down is that \$10,000 has been reinvested by Wesley in an equally stable form of savings, which will make more interest and which are readily available in case you need them.

Your overall income, that I have gone over carefully with Wesley, is about \$18,500 a year and your overall expenses last year were about \$15,800, so you're running along fine and have no need for concern.

I will drop in briefly after I finish a meeting on Sunday, March 1, in Orlando. I will just have an hour or so on the way to the airport, driving in from Orlando. But we can get caught up then.

Thank you for your recent letter. I am glad that things are moving along. Our travel plans are not quite fixed, but I would guess we would arrive in Anna Maria on the 21st or 22nd or March to stay until the end of April.
