

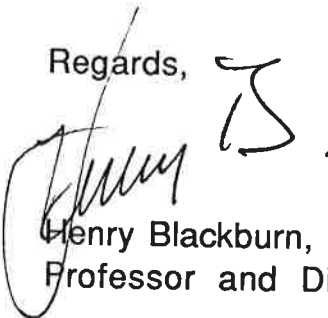

Dear Dr. Blackburn:

Some time has passed since the funeral Dr. Sullivan, and I apologize for not having responded to your letter sooner. I must admit it came as somewhat a surprise to me. In the abstract, I am aware of differences within the various cultures in our society. Your letter makes them much more personal.


In the past I've had the pleasure of attending memorial convocations within the University. The last was for one of your colleagues, Dr. John Brantner. Always I am struck by the way death is handled, and I feel that my understanding has been broadened when I attend such occasions. I hope that was the case for you and the church service for Dr. Sullivan. Certainly, your participation in our service helped to bring the two points of view into focus.

I am sorry that your feelings were not positive, and I trust and hope that the memorial for Dr. Sullivan at the University was more to your liking.

Your letter makes me realize that, in many cases, the theology and the approach to both life and death within the Episcopal Church are not generally understood by people outside of our tradition. Once more I am reminded of the various experiences of the human soul and that there are, and should be, opportunities for a variety of human emotions.

I will not try to respond to your specific comments as I believe we start from entirely different perspectives. Certainly, I respect and try to listen to your comments.
