Thanks for your call and contacts concerning AHA records of the Council on Epidemiology and Prevention. I was distressed to hear that all those original documents no longer existed. I am sure that you or I or one of us would have been happy to keep them in our library or to propose a proper site for their deposition.

On the other hand, I am happy to hear that the records are preserved and that there has been a successful history of a Council written from the microfilmed records. What was the reference again?

We agreed that the most valuable documents would be the following:
