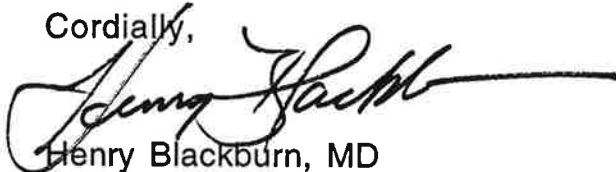
Re: Your August 28 letter about an honorary doctorate
